- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses - supporters are there to support not denigrate.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators - physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires - raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability - you'll let down your family and yourself if you do and many such comments are actually now subject to prosecution.
